




September Financials/Monthly Report - Nicolette Carlone & Mohamed Hassan

- Nicolette Carlone (PLA) and Mohamed Hassan (Gregory Terrell) reviewed the August 2015 Financials.
- Total current assets: \$130,979,690; Total Capitalized Construction Cost: \$88,000,621; Total Assets: \$219,523,139
- Total Current Liabilities: \$6,937,747; Total Liabilities: \$196,663,424; Total Liabilities & Net Position: \$219,523,139
- Total Revenue: \$7,454,212; Total Expenditures: \$3,702,920; Change in Net Position: \$3,751,292
- Net Position End of Period: \$22,859,715
- Monthly Report Exhibit A \$60,445,075.23 Under Budget
- Smart Grid: Not reflected in Financials; shall present in 2016. PLA has eight (8) vehicles and adding one (1) additional vehicle.
- Additional costs for ESRI and New World software

Project Update - Mukesh Patel and Joseph Stinolis

- Overhead Collectors, Residential and Underground Collectors and Residential near completion.
- Thoroughfares and service drives-engineering completed. Currently working on Belle Isle and Downtown lighting engineering.
- 60% of Downtown design completed should be out third week of January.
- 900 poles to be installed on Belle Isle. Investigating new technology for Belle Isle-solar battery assisted technology.





- 56,390 lights installed to date. 58-59,000 expected to be installed by end of the year. Jefferson Avenue is completed. Grand River and Michigan Avenue to be completed in 2015. Fort, Gratiot and Woodward expected to be completed in 2016. Construction is averaging 440 light installations per week with 200 foundations completed each week.
- Joseph Berry Sub and Indian Village completed by December 15th.
- Complete Collectors by end of 2015.
