March Financials/Monthly Report - Mohamed Hassan

- Mohamed Hassan reviewed the March, 2016 Financials.
- Total current assets: \$103,317,894; Total Capitalized Construction Cost: \$120,892,106; Total Assets: \$224,798,821
- Total Current Liabilities: \$9,565,902; Total Liabilities: \$199,104,350; Total Liabilities & Net Position: \$224,798,821
- Total Revenue: \$19,243,814; Total Expenditures: \$12,657,766; Change in Net Position: \$6,586,048
- Net Position End of Period: \$25,694,471



Proposed Fiscal Year Budget (July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017)

• Budget for Fiscal Year 2016/2017 was reviewed earlier during Public Hearing for Budget. No questions or comments were made.

Project Update – Mukesh Patel, Kenneth Emerson and Tom McVicar

- Mukesh Patel reports that PLA has completed all residential, collector and the majority of the thoroughfare lighting. Zip codes 48201, 48202, 48206 and 48207 underground lighting posed challenges which were successfully completed by replacing all underground wiring. Ken reported the scope of the Downtown project and the significant amount of work to be completed by the end of year 2016. PLA and DTE created maps of each quadrant of the Downtown project displayed in the Board Room as reference for daily construction meetings at the PLA.
- The PLA was awarded the 2016 Governor's Award for Historic Preservation in Lansing, Michigan on May 3, 2016. The PLA received the award for the rehabilitation of 57 century-old cast iron and wood streetlights in the Indian Village neighborhood.


